



■ Non-Accredited



Highest CAR Issue Rates by Head Criteria (22/23 FY)

- WH14-Health Surveillance and Exposure Monitoring: 39.3%
- WH17-Health & Safety Management System Audit: 35.0%
- FP1-Senior Management Commitment: 34.3%
- The Scheme lost time injury frequency rate (LTIFR) for 2022 was **1.23**, the lowest to date.
- The number of fatalities on Scheme accredited sites has remained steady over the past four years, despite significantly increasing hours.
- After six years of accreditation:
  - 62% of companies have reduced Workers Compensation Premium Rates by an average of 38%.
  - 65% of companies have reduced their Lost Time Injury Frequency Rates by an average of 88%.
