#### 1 Name

This instrument is the Federal Safety Commissioner (Federal Safety Commissioner) Delegation 2024.

### 4 Revocation

All prior delegations made under subsection 40(1) of the *Building and Construction Industry* (*Improving Productivity*) Act 2016 are revoked.

5 Delegation of powers and functions under the Federal Safety Commissioner Act 2022 and the Federal Safety Commissioner (Accreditation Scheme) Rules 2023

Subject to item 6, each power or function set out in column 1 of the tables in each of Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 is delegated to each person holding, occupying or performing the duties of a position set out in column 3 of the corresponding row, subject to any limitations on the exercise of that power or the performance of that function set out in column 4 of that row.

6 Delegations of powers and functions under the *Federal Safety Commissioner Act 2022* and the *Federal Safety Commissioner (Accreditation Scheme) Rules 2023* in relation to MPG Constructions Canberra Pty Limited (ABN 89 614 877 726)

In relation to any matter regarding the accreditation of MPG Constructions Canberra Pty Limited (ABN 89 614 877 726), all powers and functions under the *Federal Safety Commissioner Act 2022* and *Federal Safety Commissioner (Accreditation Scheme) Rules* 

2023 are delegated to the person from time to time, holding, occupying or performing the duties of the office or position of Assistant Secretary, WHS Policy, Department of Employment and Workplace Relations.

## 7 Changes to position name and severability

- (1) If the name of an office or position in the Office of the Federal Safety Commissioner changes and that office or position continues performing the same functions and duties under the new name, then the delegations to that office or position under this instrument continue unaffected.
- (2) If my purported delegation of a particular function or power under this instrument is invalid, for whatever reason, it is my intention that this does not affect the validity of any other delegation of function or power under this instrument.
